NC DKG Scholarship Committee Chair Michelle Benigno proudly introduced the 2022 scholarship recipients during the state convention in Asheville.

Angela Hill, a member of Phi Chapter (Region VI, Harnett), was awarded the Hunter-Moore Doctoral Scholarship valued at \$4,000. Hill, a resident of Coats, is pursuing an Ed. D. in Educational Leadership at Fayetteville State University. Her goal is to be capable of leading, creating, and enforcing policies that can change families and communities. She is the principal at North Whiteville Academy and has been selected to participate in the DKG Ignite program in Texas this summer.

The 2022 Post-baccalaureate Academic Scholarship, valued at \$1,000, was awarded to Amy McDonald. She is pursuing a master's degree in Professional School Counseling from the University of North Carolina at Pembroke. As a school counselor at Southern Lee High School, McDonald is working to develop skills that provide support through a social justice-focused counseling program.
