Important Changes to Dues and Membership

Chapters will now keep \$7.50 of future \$10.00 initiation fees, and \$2.50 will be sent to Eta State NC treasurer, effective immediately. International will no longer receive any of the initiation fee.

Beginning with the 2019-2020 year, dues and fees will be collected by June 30th each year. This will allow International and Eta State NC to receive dues and fees by July 1, the beginning of each DKG fiscal year.

The 2018 convention amended the DKG Constitution to include a new classification of Society members: collegiate members. Such members must pay international annual dues of \$20 but are not required to pay either an induction fee or a scholarship fee.

Why is it important for your chapter to be represented at the October 13, 2018, Fall Executive Board Meeting?

As a chapter president, you are a voting member of the Executive Board and need to be informed.

- Learning about state committees assists you in carrying out the work of International and state initiatives.
- Committee reports will be given and we will be voting on the 2018-2019 Adjusted Eta State NC Budget.
- A special report will be presented by the Ad hoc Three Site Committee that could possibly change how Eta State rotates convention sites in the future.
- Information will be shared about how your chapter can invite collegiate students to join your chapter.
- During the afternoon, Regional Directors will be meeting with chapter presidents to share other information and answer questions.
- DKG Purpose number one: To unite women educators of the world in genuine spiritual fellowship, and we do this by networking and getting to know other members.
