- All amendments to the *Standing Rules* and the Eta State organization *Bylaws* passed unanimously.
- 296 members registered for all or part-time attendance.
- 45 First-Timers.
- Biennium 2017-2019 Officer Elections: Connie Savell, President; Dr. Teresa Cowan, First Vice-President; Elizabeth Miers, Second Vice-President; and Nancy Teague, Recording Secretary were elected by unanimous vote.
- The 2018 Eta State Convention will be held at the University Hilton, Charlotte, NC with Region VI.
- Collected \$1547.12 for State Headquarters
- Voted to adopt all digital distribution of *Eta State News*.
- Heard reports from all officers, appointed personnel, and committee chairmen.
- Voted to add the position of Webmaster to the Appointed Personnel.
- Adopted the 2017-2018 Budget.
- Appointed Linda Little and Susan Kuenzel to prepare the Eta State North Carolina Updated History, 2007-2017.
- NC Education Foundation held the 2nd Annual Meeting.
- Accepted Personnel Committee's recommendation to add Carol Bostian to Appointed Personnel as *Eta State Editor* 2017-2023.
